

WSTA Passenger Alert!

Several WSTA routes will undergo minor route and/or schedules changes on Monday, December 1, 2008. Please take a moment to review the information below in order to be aware of the expected changes.

Route 3 – The outbound bus will now turn Right on Free Street, Left on Liberia and Left on Alder, ending the route on the corner of Alder and Mock Street. It will travel Inbound by turning left onto Mock Street and proceed downtown without any other changes to the route.

Route 10 – In order to better serve the community, a portion of Route 10 has changed. Route 10 will now travel Inbound past the ESC office. When the bus leaves Wal-Mart on Hanes Mill Road, it will no longer turn left onto University Parkway. Instead it will remain on Hanes Mill Road, crossing University to travel past the Employment Security Commission. It will turn left onto the Hanes Mill Road extension, past the Northside Dialysis Center and Aldi's. It will make a right turn onto University and travel inbound without any other changes to the route.

Route 16 – This bus has added an extra hour on the schedule. Therefore, the bus will travel outbound from downtown at 11:45 am Monday through Friday.

Route 23 – Due to schedule problems with the bus traveling in the area of Oakgrove and Ebert Street, the route will change. The route will no longer turn left on Miller Street to the main campus of Forsyth Tech. Instead, it will travel on Silas Creek to Ebert, where it will turn left. It will then turn left onto Oakgrove, and left on Miller Street to accommodate Forsyth Tech. It will make a left turn onto Silas Creek and exit the ramp to the right to get onto Bolton. After turning left on Bolton, the bus will go left into the parking lot of the Forsyth Tech West Campus. It will leave the parking lot heading to the right. The bus will turn left onto London Lane, left on Ebert Street, and right onto Salem Crest Lane, where the route will end. The bus will travel inbound from Salem Crest Lane making a right turn onto Ebert, right on Oakgrove, and a left onto Miller Street. It will proceed on the route without any other changes. There is a very slight change to the schedule.

Route 40— This downtown only route will extend the hours of the service. The West End Trolley/Park and Shuttle Service will operate from 6:30 am until 7:51 pm, Monday through Friday.

Route 44 – This route has changed slightly. Instead of crossing University Parkway when it leaves Wal-Mart, it will turn left onto University, and will travel past Madison Park, turning right onto the Hanes Mill Road extension. It will proceed past the Northside Dialysis Center and Millcreek Apartments, and make a left turn onto Hanes Mill Road. It will proceed on the route without any other changes.
