

Title VI Notice to Public

The City of Winston-Salem, the Winston-Salem Area Transportation Planning Organization (WSATPO) and the Winston- Salem Transit Authority (WSTA) hereby gives public notice of its policy to uphold and assume full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 49 U.S.C. 47123, and the Age Discrimination Act of 1975 (Civil Rights Laws) prohibit discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, creed, sex, or age in any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance. The City of Winston-Salem, the Winston-Salem Area Transportation Planning Organization (WSATPO) and the Winston- Salem Transit Authority (WSTA) also prohibits recipients receiving federal financial assistance from intimidating or retaliating against anyone, because he or she acts to secure rights protected by civil rights laws. If you believe your civil rights have been violated as a result of prohibited discrimination, intimidation, or retaliation you have the right to file a complaint within one hundred eighty (180) days of the last date of the prohibited act(s).
